How do we keep track of students in SIRS?

NewEach student is identified with a 10-digit number when the
student first enters the system.YorkStateStudentIdentificationSystem

The Match Game

- New enrollments are sent up to Level 2 for either a new number or to find a match
- It can take 2-3 days to get a NYSSIS ID
- If the system finds a close match, the district is notified to that they have a student in the near match queue
- Someone in the district has the responsibility to login to NYSSIS and clear the queue

Time is ticking...

- Without a NYSSIS ID <u>NO</u> data will move to Level 2
- DO NOT wait until the deadline week to enter new enrollments
- If a new student does not have a NYSSIS ID by August 17th, no data will be reported for the year
- Without a NYSSIS ID by August 17th, <u>no</u> data for the student will be available in Level 0 Historical for corrections
- Without a NYSSIS ID, anyone in Special Ed Events will not be reported
