Why are UIAS Reports Important?

- These reports are based on data at Level 2 across districts in New York State
- They are based on data gathered using the NYSSIS Id
- Give you a heads up to issues that you may not even be aware of

Helps clean up cohort and graduation data-VERY IMPORTANT!!

What type of cases do they identify?

The SIRS 701 currently includes:


- Disappearing Students: expected to be continuously enrolled in a given location, but with no re-enrollment in that location in the new school year (SY);
- False Dropouts: Students exited as dropouts but who may have subsequently reenrolled (within a given time frame or in a qualifying location) that would then suggest the dropout code be replaced with a more appropriate exit code;
- False Transfers: Students who were coded as having transferred to a new location but appear not to have re-enrolled under the requirements for that particular type of transfer; and
- Simultaneous Enrollments: Students who appear to be inappropriately enrolled in multiple locations.


