# **Reporting Nurses**

## <u>Do They Have a TEACH ID?</u>

- All teaching and non-teaching professionals need be reported through **Staff Snapshot and Staff Assignment** 
  - All teaching and non-teaching professionals need a NYS TEACH ID to be reported through the SIRS System
    - Often during the fingerprinting process a TEACH ID will be created for them
      - Districts can leverage their HR departments and check the **TEACH system for nurses that may already have an ID**

DDCs may also use the public search site

  - Be aware of those who may have had a name change after being fingerprinted
  - They may still be listed under their previous name.

  - Applicants will need to provide the following
    - Name
    - Birth Date (mm/dd/yyyy) (required for TEACH access)

    - e-mail address
    - United States Social Security Number
