### **General Information**

The Elementary- and Intermediate-level Science Tests will be administered in Grades 5 and 8, respectively, for the first time in Spring 2024. These tests are designed to measure knowledge and skills contained in New York State P-12 Science Learning Standards. The tests are administered as written examinations in the spring of each school year and consist of both multiple-choice and constructed-response (i.e., open-ended) questions. In order to prepare for these tests with authentic, hands-on laboratory experiences, students will participate in a series of required activities called *Investigations*. Like the written tests, the Investigations are aligned with the New York State P-12 Science Learning Standards but provide the opportunity for performance-based assessment of student science knowledge and skills. The Investigations are designed to be embedded into instruction and can be offered any time during the school year, dependent on when teachers cover the particular Learning Standards assessed.

The Investigations are intended for use by New York State teachers for course work and examination preparation in the classroom. Permission is hereby granted to teachers and nonprofit organizations or institutions to reproduce these materials in limited quantities for their own use, but not for sale, provided copyright notices are retained as they appear in this publication. This permission does not apply to mass distribution of these materials, electronically or otherwise.

The Teacher's Guide for each required Investigation provides an estimate of the time needed to complete the activities. The actual times needed to complete the required laboratory activities may vary depending on the length of scheduled laboratory periods, whether lab questions are to be completed in class or outside of class as homework, and if teachers choose to supplement the Investigation with additional instruction or activities. Teachers must make students aware of any specific safety precautions included in the teacher instructions for each required Investigation.

### **Required Investigations**

Teachers must be certain that all students successfully complete the required Investigations before the administration of the Elementary- or Intermediate-level Science Tests. Completion of the Investigations prepares students for the written test by providing a hands-on opportunity to demonstrate attainment of science knowledge and skills that also will be assessed on the written test. At least 15% of the questions on the written test will measure content related to the performance expectations measured by the Investigations. Other questions will assess concepts related to the activities undertaken by students in the Investigations.

Although there are benefits to completing all Investigations in the school year leading up to the written test, this is not required and the decision on when to complete the Investigations is left to local discretion. For example, if a school chooses to teach life science during Grade 7, students may complete the relevant Investigation that year rather than during Grade 8 if the school determines this to be the appropriate approach.

The four required Investigations for Elementary-level Science and the primary performance expectations measured by each are:

- Structure and Properties of Matter: What's in the Bag? (PE: 5-PS1-4)
- Weather and Climate: Cloud in a Bottle (PE: 3-ESS2-3)
- Energy: Light It Up (PE: 4-PS3-4)
- Life Cycles and Traits: Circle of Life (PE: 3-LS1-1)

The four required Investigations for Intermediate-level Science and the primary performance expectations measured by each are:

- Structures and Properties of Matter: All Mixed Up (PE: MS-PS1-8)
- Energy: Cool It! (PE: MS-PS3-4)
- Weather and Climate: Air Mass Matters (MS-ESS2-5)
- Structure Function and Information Processing: It's Alive? (MS-LS1-1)

Each of the required Investigations includes the following components:

- Teacher Directions
- Student Directions
- Student Answer Packet
- Answer/Scoring Key
- Scoring Rubric

The Student Directions and the Student Answer Packet must be duplicated in order to provide a copy for each student. Students should record all data and answers in the Student Answer Packet which must be retained by the school as evidence of the student's successful completion of the activity and should be kept on file for at least six months following the date of the test. A copy of this packet may be provided to the student in order to prepare for the written test. The Answer/Scoring Key and Scoring Rubric provide guidance on appropriately rating the

Investigations. However, all aspects of grading the required Investigations and their use in course grades are at the discretion of the teacher. Scores on the Investigations will not be reported to the State or included in the students' final test scores.

Districts are responsible for providing the equipment and supplies necessary to implement the required Investigations. The activities were specifically designed to require relatively simple and inexpensive materials. Estimated costs will vary, with some requiring minimal startup cost and others requiring a slightly higher initial investment. An equipment and materials list is provided at the end of this memo as well as in the Teacher's Directions for each Investigation.

### **Requesting Digital Copies of the Investigations**

The Investigations will be made available to schools as digital copies only. Principals will be able to access and download the files using the exam ordering portal through which they make exam requests. Digital copies of the Student Directions and Student Answer Packets in alternate languages and hard copies in Unified English Braille may be requested by contacting the Office of State Assessment at emscassessinfo@nysed.gov.

Subject: Investigations for the Elementary- and Intermediate-level Science Tests Now Available

The required Elementary- and Intermediate Level Science Investigations described in the May 2022 memorandum are now available. The Investigations are hands-on laboratory experiences that prepare students for the written Elementary- and Intermediate-level Science Tests measuring the NYS P-12 Science Learning Standards that are scheduled to be first administered in Grades 5 and 8, respectively, in Spring 2024. Principals and test coordinators may access and download the files using the exam ordering portal through which they make exam requests (see Attachment for detailed information on downloading the Investigations). Each of the required Investigations includes the following components: Teacher Materials (Investigation Overview, Teacher Directions – with specific materials list, Answer/Scoring Key), Student Directions, Student Answer Packet(s), and Scoring Rubric. The Department is finalizing copies of the Student Directions and Student Answer Packets in alternate languages and hard copies in Unified English Braille. These will be made available in the coming weeks and may be requested by contacting the Office of State Assessment.

As a reminder, the Investigations are designed to be embedded into instruction and can be offered <u>any time</u> prior to the written test. This may be when the particular Learning Standards assessed within each Investigation are covered in the course or at another time of the teacher's choosing. The Investigations provide a hands-on opportunity to demonstrate attainment of science knowledge and skills. However, the Investigations themselves are not considered a State test; rather, they are locally-administered performance-based tasks that are one of multiple components of the strategy for assessing science learning.

The Investigations are intended for use by New York State teachers in the classroom. Teachers may make the student materials available to their classes in printed or electronic form but may not post or otherwise release the materials in a public domain. Teachers are strongly encouraged to review each Investigation now that the files are available. This will ensure ample time to collect the necessary materials and plan appropriate classroom setup. Like any other classroom activity, students must be provided with supports and accommodations as detailed in their Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 Accommodation Plan while completing the Investigations.

The Office of State Assessment is currently working with partners in the field to develop additional resources that will assist teachers as they familiarize themselves with the Investigations and prepare to implement them in their classrooms. ### **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- In order to access the required Elementary- and Intermediate-Level Science Investigations, you must have access to the <u>NYSED Business Application Portal</u> and the Office of State Assessment Online Examination Request System. 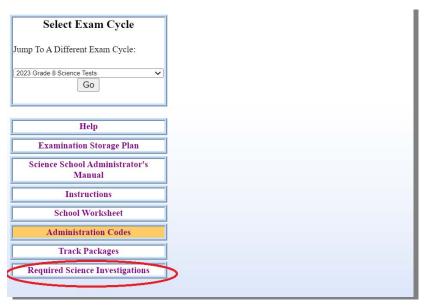

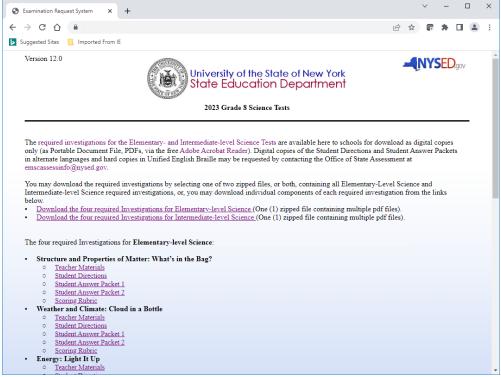

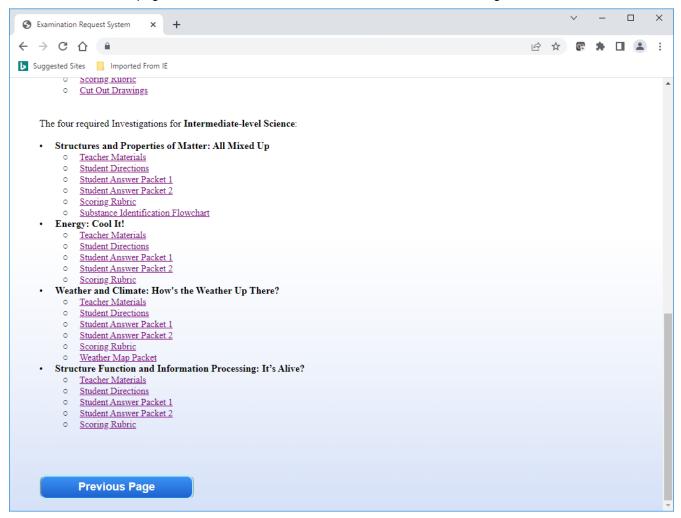

Subject: Administration of the New York State Alternate Assessment in the 2022-23

School Year

This memorandum provides important information about the administration of the New York State Alternate Assessment (NYSAA) beginning with the 2022-23 school year. Students eligible to participate in the NYSAA are assessed in English language arts (ELA), mathematics, and science using the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) Alternate Assessment System. The NYSAA is part of the State testing program that measures student knowledge on Essential Elements, which are alternate achievement standards that are reduced in depth and breadth from the learning standards.

### NYSAA in Science

In December 2016, the Board of Regents adopted the new P-12 Science Learning Standards which are based on the Framework for K-12 Science Education developed by the Research Council and the Next Generation Science Standards. The DLM Essential Elements in science are specific statements of knowledge and skills that are linked to the grade-level expectations in the Framework for K-12 Science Education.

Students participating in the NYSAA in science are assessed once each at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. Beginning with the 2023-24 school year and thereafter, NYSAA eligible students will be tested in science in grade 5, grade 8, and one time in high school. As the Board of Regents and the Department work to <u>implement the science learning standards</u>, students eligible to participate in the grade 4 NYSAA in science will not be tested in the 2022-23 school year. Instead, these students will be tested in grade 5 the following year (spring 2024). This is consistent with the implementation of the Elementary- and Intermediate-level Science Assessments.

### **NYSAA** in English Language Arts and Mathematics

Students will continue to take the NYSAA English language arts and mathematics tests in grades 3-8 and once in high school. As in past years, these tests will measure the DLM Essential Elements in <u>ELA</u> and <u>math</u>. The Department and DLM Consortium staff are currently working together on alignment studies to link the <u>New York State Next Generation Learning Standards</u> with the DLM Essential Elements. However, these linkages will not impact the student experience or how teachers prepare students for the assessment. The Essential Elements in these subject areas remain unchanged.

The Department and the DLM Consortium will continue to work cooperatively to ensure that students, teachers, and administrators have the necessary supports for successful assessment. Reminder: all NYSAA-eligible students noted in the secondary-level age range above are assigned to the Grade 9 cohort in Educator Portal, regardless of the actual grade that the student is enrolled in at school. The grade must be 9 in the Educator Portal system.

<sup>\*\*</sup>NYSAA-eligible students who do not meet the age criteria above for the secondary level and will be exiting school before they reach their eighteenth birthday must take the secondary-level NYSAA before they leave school (i.e., when they are 17 years old). NYSAA-eligible secondary-level students who were expected to participate in the spring 2020, spring 2021, or spring 2022 NYSAA administration but could not do so are not expected to take the NYSAA before they exit school.
