Ending ELL Eligibility

 - the students scored at the Expanding level on the NYSESLAT,
 - AND**
 - either scored Proficient (Level 3 or 4) on grades 3-8 ELA assessment OR scored 65 or higher on a Regents examination in English Regents.
- ▶ **3045**-*ELL Eligibility Exit based on review of identification determination* —ELL eligibility ended because the student was determined by the district to have been misidentified as ELL

- ▶ Schools are not permitted to administer Levels II-VIII from July 1-July 14
